

The Supercar Event 2018

All the important information you need to know before coming to the event

Tickets

Remember to pre-book your entrance and ride tickets to save money and to book a ride slot. For prices and to book please visit www.thesupercarevent.co.uk

Pre-booking

We suggest you pre-book to get the advance purchase rate and to guarantee your slot time.

It's less busy at 10:00am with the busiest times between 11:00 - 12:30 and after lunch, 14:00 - 15:30. It's likely these times could sell out, although we do try and hold some tickets back for sales on the day.

Supercar rides

For just £30 in advance (£35 on the day) why not book a passenger ride in a supercar for yourself?

The event offers a whole range of luxury vehicles to choose from including Ferrari F430s, Lamborghini Gallardos and Audi R8s. A supercar ride ticket entitles you ride in the next available car in the queue.

Want to have more choice about the car you ride in? Then book a fast track ticket which allows you to choose from 12 cars on the grid when you reach the front of the queue.

Fast track supercar rides

Fast track ride tickets are available from £60 per ride and offer you the choice of riding in any of the 12 cars on the grid when you reach the front of the queue (with the exception of the hypercars which are individually priced due to the likelihood of only one or two of each being present).

In addition to the normal cars, this group includes F40s Carrera GTs, Mosler MT900S and a few more that we keep up our sleeve until nearer the time.

Driving requests

Sadly, unless you're one of the hand-picked drivers, you won't be able to drive your car. If you have a suitable

vehicle we can consider you, please contact the event team in advance by emailing supercar@thechildrenstrust.org.uk.

Please don't turn up on the day expecting to be able to drive as all our drivers have to be registered and complete the necessary documentation in advance to permit them to drive.

Driving supercars

Attendees are not permitted to drive the supercars. The owners drive their cars - it's a condition set by the venue.

Children's supercar rides

At most events, rides in supercars are limited to adults only. What sets us aside from other events is that children can also enjoy supercar rides in some of the fastest cars in the world.

Additional tickets can be purchased for supercar rides (starting from £30) and children can ride as a passenger provided:

- they are over 8 years of age;
- if under 1.35m they must use the booster seat provided.
- they MUST wear a helmet
- they cannot ride in specialist open top cars if aged between 8-16.

Important Information

No dogs, other than assistance dogs are permitted into the event area. Dogs are not allowed to be left in vehicles.

No drones are permitted on site. Anyone found in possession of a drone will be asked to leave immediately and tickets will be revoked.

The venue

Our new venue for 2018 is Rockingham in Corby, Northamptonshire. With easy access from the M1, Rockingham provides full motorsports facilities. As such, the event unsurprisingly revolves around the Oval Circuit with various rides on offer. In addition, we have a whole plethora of other attractions ranging from helicopter rides, Caterham Seven rides and food and drink outlets to provide refreshment all day long.

By car

The best way to get to Rockingham is by car and there is ample parking on-site. Rockingham's postcode is NN17 5AF, however please also enter Mitchell Road as a destination if possible, or follow signposts when getting closer to the venue as some sat-navs will direct you to the rear of site.

By public transport

The nearest train station is Corby which is 35 minutes away from the venue by bus and on foot. Please check the bus services at weekends before you book your tickets. Visit www.stagecoachbus.com for further information.

Parking

Free parking is available on-site for all visitors. Disabled parking is available to those with a valid Blue Badge.

Facilities

As well as the food village, toilets are available free of charge on-site and the venue has full medical facilities.

Picnics

Attendees are welcome to bring a picnic and a dedicated picnic area will be available across both event days. Please remember to bring a blanket as there are no picnic tables or chairs.

Cash points

Please note there are NO cash machines on-site and a cash-back service will not be available.

We suggest you bring cash with you as this speeds up the ticket queues but we do accept cards (not American Express) for supercar ride purchases on the day.

Weather - both good and bad

Like most outdoor events, we have limited shelter if it rains, or if it is too hot. Please come prepared for all eventualities with wet weather gear and sun protection.

Drones

Under no circumstances are drones permitted on-site or throughout the event. Due to the nature of the event, drones pose a safety risk and anybody found in possession of one will be asked to leave immediately and tickets will be revoked.
